HAVING REGARD to the presidential decree no. 19/2023 signed by the President of the CREF with which was approved the financing of 1 training research grant within the PRIN 2022 WECARE (CUP F53D23001010006) with the title "WEaving Complexity And the gReen Economy (WECARE)";

HAVING REGARD to resolution no. 98/2023 of the CREF Board of Directors, with which the presidential decree no. 19/2023 was ratified;

HAVING REGARD to the CREF Board of Directors resolution no. 98/2023 that has ratified the presidential decree no. 19 of 14th December 2023;

HAVING REGARD to decision no. 70/2024 which concluded the public selection procedure no. 2(24), for lack of candidates;

HAVING REGARD to the request no. 2414/2024, with which Dr. Dario Mazzilli, Head of the research unit and the scientific contact of the project, asked to publish again the public selection referred to the Call no. 2(24), confirming the same subject and the same requirements for admission, in order to ensure the start of the planned research activities as soon as possible, in accordance with the deadlines required by the abovementioned scientific project and its natural expiry;

CONSIDERED therefore APPROPRIATE, in execution of the above-mentioned request and the aforementioned considerations, to proceed with a new publication of the public selection, based on qualifications and interview, for the assignment of 1 training research grant for a duration of 12 months, possibly renewable, with an amount equal to € 22.699,02, net of social security contributions to be paid by the Administration, as part of the Project PRIN 2022 WECARE (CUP F53D23001010006), with the title "WEaving Complexity And the gReen Economy (WECARE)", at CREF;

HAVING REGARD to the request no. 2723/2024, with which the scientific contact of the project scheduled the date for the meeting and proposed a date for taking up service, asking for both to be included in this call;

HAVING REGARD to the budget forecast for the year 2024 approved with the resolution of the Board of Directors no. 117/2023;

HAVING ASSURED the financial coverage to support the annual costs for the implementation of the research grant, in the relevant chapters of the budget forecast for the year 2024;

DECREES

Art. 1 – Object of the public selection

1. The CREF announces a public selection, based on qualifications and interview, for the awarding of n. 1 training research grant lasting 12 months, possibly renewable, for carrying out research activities at the CREF, as part of the Project PRIN 2022 WECARE (CUP F53D23001010006).
2. The contract is governed by private law as specified below:
 - Type of research grant: Training
 - Gross amount for the administration (including social security cost): € 28.000,00
 - Gross amount: € 22.699,02
 - Title: WEaving Complexity And the gReen Economy (WECARE)
 - Tutor: Dott. Dario Mazzilli
3. The research activity will focus on study and characterization of the Optimal Transport theory in the context of economic complexity.
4. The research grant is paid to the contract holder in equal monthly installments.
5. This call, as well as all related information, news and indications are published on the CREF institutional website at the address www.cref.it.

Art. 2 – Admission requirements for selection

1. Scholars in possession of a professional scientific curriculum suitable for carrying out the scientific research activities envisaged by this announcement can participate in the selection procedure, as well as in possession of the following requirements:
 - a. age no less than 18 years;
 - b. enjoyment of civil and political rights in the countries of origin;
 - c. absence of criminal convictions or ongoing criminal proceedings that could prevent the establishment of the collaborative relationship pursuant to current legislation;
 - d. knowledge of the english language;
 - e. knowledge of the Italian language (only for foreign candidates);
 - f. specialist degree (LS) or master's degree (LM) and equivalent or degree diploma (DL) obtained according to the methods prior to the entry into force of the Ministerial Decree 509/1999 and subsequent amendments and equivalent qualifications for the purposes of admission to public competitions, in Mathematics, or Computer science, or Physics, or Economics.
2. The qualification obtained abroad must be recognized as valid in Italian territory.
For qualifications obtained abroad that have not already been recognized in Italy with a formal procedure pursuant to current legislation, the Examining Commission is competent to evaluate equivalence by nature, level and disciplinary correspondence (degree class or CUN Area for doctoral qualifications) to

the qualification required by this announcement in accordance with the procedures set out in the Regulations for the awarding of CREF research grants.

3. The following **are not admitted to the selective procedure**:
 - a. those who have a degree of kinship or affinity, up to and including the fourth degree, with a researcher, the Administrative Director or a member of the Board of Directors;
 - b. those who have been holders, including any renewals, of research grants awarded pursuant to art. 22 of Law 240/2010 for a period which, added to the duration of the contract provided for in this announcement, exceeds a total of six years (excluding the period in which the grant was used in conjunction with the research doctorate within the maximum limit of legal duration of the relevant course);
 - c. those who have benefited from research grants and carried out activities as fixed-term researchers, pursuant to articles 22 and 24 of Law no. 240/2010, at the University or other Universities, whether state, non-state or telematic, as well as at the bodies referred to in the art. 22 paragraph 1 of Law no. 240/2010, for a period which, added to the duration foreseen for the contract which is the subject of the selection in which they intend to participate, exceeds twelve years, even if not continuous. For the purposes of the aforementioned duration, periods spent on leave for maternity or health reasons according to current legislation are not relevant;
 - d. permanent staff at universities, institutions and public research and experimentation bodies, the National Agency for new technologies, energy and sustainable economic development (ENEA) and the Italian Space Agency (ASI), as well as the institutions whose scientific specialization diploma has been recognized as equivalent to the title of research doctor pursuant to article 74, fourth paragraph of the decree of the President of the Republic no. 382/1980.
4. Candidates enrolled in degree courses, specialist or master's degrees, research doctorates with scholarship or medical specialization, in Italy or abroad can participate in the selection in question; if they are winners, the research grant will be awarded to them after renouncing their studies or the doctoral scholarship.
5. The prescribed requirements must be met on the expiry date of the deadline for submitting the application for admission to this selection.
6. The CREF Administration guarantees equality and equal opportunities between men and women for access to work and treatment at work.

Art. 3 – Exclusion from selection

1. The following reasons are grounds for exclusion:
 - a. failure to sign the participation application form;
 - b. lack of admission requirements established by art. 2;

- c. failure to comply with the procedures for submitting the application for participation referred to in subsequent art. 4.
2. Candidates are admitted to the selection with reservations; if a supplementary investigation is necessary, they are required to regularize their request within the peremptorily assigned deadlines.
 3. The examining commission may, at any time, with a reasoned provision, exclude the candidate from the selection announced with this announcement.

Art. 4 – Method and deadline for submission of the admission application

1. Applications must be drawn up using the form attached to this announcement (Annex A) and must be received **no later than 11.59 p.m. on 9th September 2024**. Late applications will not be taken into consideration.
2. Foreign candidates must send the application via e-mail to the address: segreteria@cref.it and they will receive a confirmation e-mail. It is a candidate's responsibility to verify the arrival of the confirmation, otherwise they must contact the CREF administrative office. The application must be submitted reporting in the email subject “Call no. 4(24) – Training research grant”. A single folder in ZIP format containing all the documents required by this announcement, including attachments, in PDF format must be attached to the e-mail.
3. Applications not submitted according to the attached form (Annex A and B) or without the candidate's signature will be excluded from the selection procedure.

Art. 5 – Admission request

1. Aware that false declarations are punishable by law and that the Administration will carry out random checks on their accuracy, the applicant must declare clearly and precisely in the application (Annex A), under his own responsibility, pursuant to what provided for by Presidential Decree 445/2000 and subsequent amendments and additions, as follows:
 - a) name and surname, date and place of birth;
 - b) tax code (only for Italian citizens);
 - c) place of residence and email address for correspondence;
 - d) citizenship;
 - e) to know the foreign language required by this announcement; the applicant with citizenship other than Italian must also declare that he has knowledge of the Italian language;
 - f) possession of civil and political rights in the country of origin;
 - g) physical suitability for the job for which one is competing (the Administration may order checks pursuant to art. 41 of Legislative Decree no. 81/2008);
 - h) not to have any criminal convictions, or to declare any convictions suffered, indicating the details of the relevant sentences, and any pending criminal proceedings;

- i) to be/not to be an employee of the State, specifying to be/not to be an employee of universities and other bodies referred to in the art. 22 of Law no. 240/2010;
 - j) if enrolled in a Bachelor's Degree (DL), Specialist Degree (LS), Master's Degree (LM), or Research Doctorate with scholarship or medical specialization, in Italy or abroad, to be aware that, in case of obtaining the grant, attendance at these courses and the use of the doctoral scholarship is incompatible with the maintenance of the contract;
 - k) to possess the requirements set out in art. 2 of this announcement, indicating the degree cycle, the date of achievement, the Institute that issued it and the final grade/evaluation achieved; the candidate with qualification(s) obtained abroad must declare that they have obtained the relevant recognition by indicating in the application the details of the measure or must attach the required documentation as specified in this announcement;
 - l) to possess every other requirement referred to the art. 2 of this call;
 - m) (if any) to have been the holder of research grants awarded pursuant to art. 22 of Law no. 240/2010 and their duration;
 - n) (if any) to have been the holder of fixed-term researcher contracts pursuant to art. 24 of Law no. 240/2010 and their duration;
 - o) not to be in situations of incompatibility referred to the art. 2 paragraph 3 of this announcement.
2. The application form (Annex A) must be signed by the candidate under penalty of exclusion. When submitting the application to participate in the selection, the candidate must attach the following documents:
- a) copy of the candidate's valid identity document or passport;
 - b) curriculum vitae in European format, dated and signed; the curriculum vitae must contain the following authorization "*I authorize the processing of personal data pursuant to EU Regulation GDPR 2016/679*";
 - c) qualifications deemed suitable for selection purposes such as specialist degrees, certificates of attendance at specialization courses, obtained in Italy or abroad, contracts, scholarships or research assignments both in Italy and abroad (see Annex B);
 - d) a maximum of n. 3 scientific publications including original articles in journals and conference proceedings (including any articles in printed journals) on the research topic covered by the call;
 - e) a signed summary list of all documents presented for the purposes of this selection;
 - f) in the case of a foreign candidate, it is necessary to attach a copy of a residence permit (if the candidate already has one).
3. As regards qualifications obtained abroad, to be admitted to the selection, the candidate is required to:

- if recognized as valid in Italian territory, the candidate must indicate in the application the details of the provision which certifies the recognition, comparability and equivalence of the qualifications obtained abroad;
 - if not recognized as valid in Italian territory, the candidate must attach a copy of the qualifications obtained abroad (mandatory attachment), with the certificate of the exams taken or the diploma supplement certificate. The Administration reserves the right to request the translation of these documents into Italian or English.
4. For all other qualifications obtained abroad that the candidate intends to provide for the selection foreseen in the announcement, it is necessary to attach a copy of the qualifications to the application.
 5. The requirements and qualifications must be possessed on the expiry date of the announcement.
 6. The Administration has the right to carry out appropriate checks on the truthfulness of the content of the substitute declarations in accordance with the provisions of Presidential Decree 445/2000.
 7. It is mandatory to indicate a personal certified email address to which communications relating to this selection will be sent. Any change in this address must be promptly communicated to the email address centrofermi@pec.centrofermi.it (or, only for foreign candidates, to segreteria@cref.it).

Art. 6 – Examining commission

1. The examining commission is appointed by the Board of Directors of the CREF, after consulting the Scientific Director and the Administrative Director.
2. The Commission is made up of three effective members, one of which must be the Head of the research unit and an alternate member, internal or external to the organization, with the profile of researchers or university professors (possibly also retired), or experts in the subject.
3. The Commission can also carry out the selection procedure electronically.
4. The Commission has the right to appoint a secretary who takes minutes of the meetings.

Art. 7 – Selection

1. In its first meeting, the examining commission will explicitly establish the evaluation criteria and methods, according to what is stated in the announcement.
2. The overall rating is expressed in cents, as indicated below:
 - a. up to a maximum of 60/100 points for qualifications and for scientific-professional curriculum vitae; for this purpose the following will be awarded:
 - up to 10 points for the degree grade;
 - up to 10 points for a maximum of 3 (three) publications and other research products related to the research grant;
 - up to 15 points for documented research activities in subjects relating to the research grant indicated as indicated in this announcement, both in Italy and abroad;

- up to 25 points for the curriculum vitae (scientific training, participation in conferences, knowledge of methods and analysis tools relevant to the call, PhD relating to the research grant).
 - b. up to a maximum of 40/100 points for the interview, which will focus on the subjects covered by the research grant.
3. Candidates are informed about the results of qualifications assessment before the interview by email to the address indicated in the application form.
 4. Candidates who have obtained at least 40/60 points available for their qualifications and scientific-professional curriculum vitae are admitted to the interview.
 5. The interview can be carried out by videoconference, subject to authorization from the Commission, provided that the identity of the applicant can be recognized with certainty. For this purpose, the applicant must show a valid identity document during the interview.
 6. **The interview will take place on 18th September 2024.** The possible choice of the interview in telematic modality, the relative link of access and the timetable will be published exclusively on the institutional site of the CREF in the section "Calls and Tenders" within the 13th September 2024. These communications will constitute a full notification.
 7. **Failure to submit to the interview will be considered as a refusal to participate in the competition to all intents and purposes.**
 8. During the interview, the Commission will verify the candidate's ability to deal with the topics and issues relating to the research grant in question and his knowledge of at least one foreign language, as required by the announcement. The interview will also focus on the course of study undertaken and any work experience.
 9. **The interview can also be carried out in English, upon request of the candidate.**
 10. During the interview, for foreign candidates only, knowledge of the Italian language will also be assessed.
 11. At the end of the work, the Commission draws up the list of candidates examined, indicating the marks obtained during the interview.
 12. Candidates will be included in the merit ranking if they have obtained a score of at least 25/40 points in the interview.
 13. The Commission draws up the ranking in decreasing order according to the overall final score, which is obtained by adding the score of the qualifications and the scientific-professional curriculum vitae and the score of the interview. The overall final score identifies the winner or winners, depending on the number of checks placed in the competition.
 14. The merit ranking is approved, subject to verification of the requirements set out in the announcement, by order of the Administrative Director, and published on the CREF institutional website in the "Calls and Tenders" section. The deadline for submitting any appeals starts from the date of publication.

15. In case of renunciation or withdrawal of the winning candidate from the contract, the grant may be awarded to the winners according to the order of the ranking.
16. The CREF does not provide for the reimbursement of any expenses incurred by candidates for participating in the interview.

Art. 8 – Contract

1. The winning candidate will sign a private law contract with effect from 28th September 2024.
1. For foreign applicants for whom a residence permit is necessary, the effective date of the contract will be postponed and subordinated to the completion of the process for issuing the permit itself.
2. The winner of the selection, summoned by the Human Resources Office to sign the contract via email, will lose the right to the grant for collaboration in research activities, if he does not declare acceptance of the contract or does not start the activity within the deadline communicated, without prejudice to duly and promptly documented health reasons or causes of force majeure.

Art. 9 – Rights, duties and obligations

1. The relationship is governed by an individual contract, in accordance with the provisions of the applicable laws and the CREF Regulations.
2. The research activity is flexible, has a continuous nature, not merely occasional, and is carried out under the guidance of the Lead of the research activity, with conditions of autonomy with respect to the research program and its implementation, without working hours predetermined.
3. The grant holder must refer to the research Structure that requested the activation of the contract.
4. The grant holder's research activity is carried out at the CREF headquarters. Any research activities carried out at other structures must be authorized pursuant to art. 13 of the CREF Regulations for the awarding of research grants.
5. The grant holder must annually submit to the CREF a detailed written report on the research activity carried out, accompanied by the opinion of the scientific contact of the project and the judgment of the Scientific Director.
6. For serious breaches the contract can be terminated with a reasoned provision from the Administrative Director.

Art. 10 – Publicity of the selection and Responsible of the procedure

1. This call and the related attached forms are published on the CREF website in the “Calls and Tenders” section.

Art. 11 – Privacy policy

1. The application for the selection in question implies, for the purpose of the management of the selection procedure, the processing of the personal data of the candidates in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (General Data Protection Regulation) (hereinafter Regulation).
2. In application of art. 13 of the Regulations, the Museo Storico della Fisica e Centro Studi e Ricerche “Enrico Fermi” (hereinafter “CREF”), as Data Controller, informs the candidates of the procedure that the personal data provided and/or otherwise acquired will be used exclusively for purposes related and instrumental to the conduct of the selective procedure, as specified below. CREF will process personal data (first name, last name, date and place of birth, fiscal/tax ID code, residence, citizenship), contact information, identity document/residency permit, curriculum vitae, titles, and what the candidate provided when submitting the application. Special categories of data pertaining to (i) judicial data (e.g., any criminal convictions), (ii) health-related data (e.g., disability, including temporary) may also be collected and processed at the applicant’s request.
3. The processing of personal data provided is based:
 - i. on art. 6 letter b) of the GDPR: “processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract”;
 - ii. on art. 6 letter c) of the GDPR: “processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject.”
 - iii. on art. 6 letter e) of the GDPR “processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller”, and it is aimed at the management of the selection procedure, in all its stages, from the verification of the existence of the requirements to the verification of the absence of causes preventing participation, up to the publication of the ranking list and the possible conclusion of the employment contract.
4. Judicial data and data concerning health status are possibly given on a voluntary basis by the candidate and exclusively to enable CREF to perform its public functions in protecting its interests related to the conduct of the selection procedure. For this reason, although they are of a special nature, in accordance with art. 9 par. 2) of the GDPR, the candidate’s consent is not required for their processing. The provision of data is mandatory; therefore, any refusal to provide it will result in exclusion from the selection.
5. The processing of the candidate’s personal data is carried out, also with electronic instruments, by means of the operations indicated in art. 4 par. 2) of the GDPR and precisely: the processing of personal data may consist of the collection, recording, organization, consultation, processing, modification, selection,

extraction, comparison, use, interconnection, blocking, communication, cancellation and destruction of data.

6. The candidate's data will be disclosed to the staff of the CREF as well as to the members of the examining commission, specifically authorized to process them, as well as in the capacity of Data Processors, external legal, tax and labor consultants, or the company that manages the databases where these data are stored. It is specified that CREF may also communicate the personal data it holds to other public administrations if they have to process the same for any procedures of their own institutional competence, as well as to all those public entities to which, in the presence of the relevant prerequisites, the communication is mandatorily provided for by EU provisions, laws or regulations. In particular, they may also be communicated to: Certifying Administrations during the control of substitute declarations made for the purposes of Presidential Decree no. 445/2000, Judicial Authorities.
7. Candidate's personal and/or special data are processed within the territory of the European Union and are not disseminated. If necessary, for technical or operational reasons, the Data Controller reserves the right to transfer your Personal Data to countries outside the European Union for which there are adequacy decisions of the European Commission, i.e. based on adequate safeguards provided by the country to which the data is to be transferred or on the basis of the specific exceptions provided for in the Regulations.
8. The aforementioned data will be kept as long as necessary for the conduct of the competitive procedure and because of the potential legal actions that can be exercised, or, in the case of pending litigation, until the res judicata of the relevant judgment. Subsequently, after the conclusion of the administrative or judicial proceedings, the data will be kept in accordance with the rules on the preservation of documentation provided for the Public Administration.
