



OBJECT: PUBLIC SELECTION FOR THE AWARDING OF ONE SCHOLARSHIP, BASED ON QUALIFICATIONS AND INTERVIEW, FOR MASTER'S DEGREE GRADUATES, WITH A DURATION OF TWELVE MONTHS AND A GROSS AMOUNT PAYABLE TO THE RECIPIENT OF €25,000.00, WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE EXTREME ENERGY EVENTS – SCIENCE IN SCHOOLS PROJECT, ENTITLED “EEE PROJECT: COSMIC RAYS AND SCIENCE COMMUNICATION.” **CALL N. 3(26)**

HAVING REGARD to the Integrated Activity and Organization Plan (PIAO) 2025–2027 of CREF, approved by the Board of Directors by Resolution No. 68/2025;

HAVING REGARD to the Resolution of the Board of Directors No. 9/2026, by which a public selection procedure was initiated for the awarding of a scholarship, based on qualifications and interview, for Master’s degree graduates, with a duration of twelve months and a gross amount payable to the recipient of €25,000.00, within the framework of the Extreme Energy Events – Science in Schools project, entitled “EEE Project: Cosmic Rays and Science Communication”;



HAVING REGARD to the availability of budget funds in the UGov accounting system for the 2026 financial year, amounting to a total of EUR 27,125.00, of which: EUR 25,000.00 to be charged to CoAn item CA.C.1.01.01.01.109 – Research training scholarships; and EUR 2,125.00 to be charged to CoAn item CA.C.1.01.02.01.008 – IRAP charges for research scholarships;

CONSIDERING IT NECESSARY, therefore, to recruit a resource to collaborate and provide support for the activities of the “Extreme Energy Events – Science in Schools” project;

CONSIDERING IT NECESSARY to issue a call in order to initiate the relevant public selection procedure;

DETERMINES

Article 1 – Object

The Museo storico della fisica e Centro studi e ricerche “Enrico Fermi” – CREF- announces a public selection for the awarding of one scholarship for the project Extreme Energy Events – Science in Schools, entitled “EEE Project: Cosmic Rays and Science Communication”, with the following characteristics:

Article 2 – Admission requirements

1. The admission requirements are the following:
 - a) possession of civil and political rights in the countries of origin or citizenship;
 - b) not having been dismissed, discharged, or declared disqualified from public office in a public administration;
 - c) adequate knowledge of the English language and Italian language (for foreign candidates only);
 - d) University degree (laurea) in Physics (LM-17), obtained no more than two years prior to the



application deadline.

Article 3 – Incompatibility

1. The scholarship cannot be combined with other scholarships, grants, contracts, research assignments, or other subsidies and assignments of a similar nature.
2. The scholarship is incompatible with full-time or part-time public or private employment and cannot be combined with income from professional or similar activities, or salaries and remuneration of any kind.
3. The scholarship cannot be awarded to those who have already benefited of research grants, contracts, or research assignments, post-doctoral assignments at CREF, universities, other research bodies, or foreign scientific institutions that have the same level of educational qualification as an admission requirement, for the maximum provided for by law (Law No. 240/2010).

Article 4 – Exclusion from the selection

1. The following are grounds for exclusion:
 - a) failure to meet the admission requirements set out in Article 2;
 - b) incompatibility as set out in Article 3;
 - c) failure to comply with the procedures for submitting the application form as set out in Article 5 below;
 - d) failure to sign the application form.
2. Applicants are admitted to the selection process with reserve; if further investigation is necessary, they must regularize or supplement their application within the deadlines set by the person responsible for the procedure.
3. The examination of the requirements and the possession of the qualifications are subject to the unquestionable judgment of the Examination Board. The CREF may, at any time, with a reasoned decision, exclude applicants who do not meet the requirements. This decision will be communicated by certified email or email.

Article 5 – Application for admission

1. Applications must be submitted using the forms attached to this call (Annex A and B) and **sent within 10 days from the day following the publication of this call on the CREF institutional website www.cref.it**. The application form (Annex A) must be signed by the applicant, otherwise the application will be rejected.
2. Foreign applicants who do not have a certified email address may send their application by email to:



segreteria@cref.it and will receive an email confirming receipt. It is applicant's responsibility to check that the confirmation email has been received. If not, they must contact the person responsible for the procedure indicated below. The application must be sent with the **subject "Call n.3(26) – Extreme Energy Events – Science in Schools"**.

3. Applicants must indicate and declare in the application form (Annex A) the following informations:
 - a) name, surname, date and place of birth;
 - b) Italian tax code (if available);
 - c) place of residence;
 - d) telephone number, email address, certified email address (if available);
 - e) citizenship;
 - f) possession of civil and political rights in the country of origin or citizenship;
 - g) not to have criminal convictions or ongoing criminal proceedings;
 - h) to have adequate knowledge of the English language and of the Italian language (for foreign candidates only);
 - i) possession of the academic qualifications required for admission as specified in this call, indicating the date of graduation, the university/institution, and the grade;
 - j) not to be incompatible with the provisions of the CREF Regulation for the awarding of scholarships (Article 4);
 - k) meet all other requirements set out in this call for applications.
4. In addition to the annex A, applicants must send:
 - a) curriculum vitae in European format, dated and signed, demonstrating the possession of the required qualifications, experience, and skills;
 - b) documents relating to the activities of the scholarship that the applicant deems appropriate to submit;
 - c) annex B, containing the substitute declaration pursuant to Articles 46 and 47 of Presidential Decree No. 445/2000;
 - d) copy of a valid identification document;
 - e) in the case of foreign applicant (extra EU), a copy of a residence permit (if the applicant already has one).
5. For qualifications obtained abroad, to be admitted to the selection process, applicants must:
 - a) in case of qualifications recognized as valid in Italy, indicate the details of the provision certifying the recognition, comparability, and equivalence of the qualifications obtained abroad;
 - b) in case of qualifications not recognized as valid in Italy, must attach a copy of the qualifications obtained abroad (mandatory attachment), with the certificate of exams taken or the diploma



supplement certificate. CREF reserves the right to request a translation of these documents into Italian or English.

6. The requirements set out in this call must be met by the deadline for submission of the application for admission.
7. CREF reserves the right to carry out appropriate checks on the truthfulness of the content of the self-declarations, in accordance with Presidential Decree No. 445/2000.
8. It is mandatory to indicate a personal certified email (PEC) address to which communications relating to this selection procedure will be sent. Foreign candidates are required to indicate a standard (non-certified) email address. Any change to the indicated email address must be promptly communicated to the following email address: centrofermi@pec.centrofermi.it (or, for foreign candidates only, to segreteria@cref.it).

Article 6 – Points and selection

1. The maximum score for the selection is 200 points, divided as follows:

| The interview will focus on: cosmic ray physics, the EEE Project; science communication tools; any experience gained in related fields and relevant skills possessed. During the interview, proficiency in the English language will also be assessed. |

2. At its first meeting, the Examination Board shall establish the criteria and methods of evaluation.
3. The evaluation of qualifications may be carried out by the examining committee on the same day of its first session, following the conclusion of the initial meeting. In any case, the evaluation of qualifications is carried out by the selection committee before the interview.
4. Applicants shall be informed of the results of the evaluation of qualifications before the interview by ordinary email or certified email to the address indicated in the application form.
5. Applicants who have obtained at least 42/60 of the points available for qualifications, as referred to in



paragraph 1, are admitted to the interview.

6. The overall evaluation results from the sum of the scores obtained in the assessment of qualifications and in the interview.
7. The interview is considered passed with a minimum score of 98/140 points.
8. Applicants who obtain a minimum total score of 140/200 points (assessment of qualifications and interview) are included in the final ranking of successful candidates.
9. At the conclusion of its proceedings, the committee shall draw up the final report containing the ranking of the candidates, listed in descending order according to the total final score obtained by summing the scores of the qualifications.
10. In case of a tie in the overall score, priority in the ranking shall be given in the following order:
 - a) applicant with the highest degree score;
 - b) applicant with the highest score obtained in the interview;
 - c) applicant who, with equal merit and equal qualifications, is the winner based on the preference qualifications referred to in Article 5, paragraph 4 of Presidential Decree No. 487/1994;
 - d) in the event of a further tie, the youngest applicant.
11. At the end of the selection process, the results will be published at the website of the call (www.cref.it) and, in any case, applicants will be informed by email about the result of their interview.
12. The acts of the selection procedure are approved by the Administrative Director within thirty days from the submission of the committee's reports to the Officer in charge of the procedure. By the same measure, the ranking is approved and the winner of the selection is declared. This measure is published on the official CREF website under the "Competitions and Notices" page, ensuring compliance with the principles of transparency and personal data protection. The deadline for submitting any appeals begins from the date of publication.
13. In the event of withdrawal or termination of the contract by the selected candidate, the scholarship may be awarded to the next eligible candidate in the ranking.

Article 7 – Interview

1. The procedures, date, time, and location of the interview will be communicated through the publication of the call on the CREF website, under the "Competitions and Notices" section, on the page relating to this call, at least 15 days before the scheduled date. This communication shall serve as official notification for all purposes.
2. For foreign applicants, the interview may also be conducted in English, upon the candidate's request. In such cases, knowledge of the Italian language will also be assessed.
3. Failure to attend the interview will be considered as withdrawal from the competition, regardless of



the reasons for the absence, even if due to force majeure.

Article 8 – Examination Board

1. The Examination Board is appointed by the President order, after consultation with the Administrative Director and the Scientific Director, and it's composed of a chairperson and two or more members, ensuring gender balance unless there is a justified reason for not doing so. Substitutes may be appointed for both the chairperson and the individual members.
2. The Examination Board may carry out the selection process using telematic methods and tools for collegial work.
3. The Examination Board must complete its work within two months of the date of appointment. In the event of justified impediment and at the request of the Examination Board, the President may grant an extension of up to a maximum of two additional months.
4. The composition of the Examination Board is published on the CREF website.

Article 9 – Publication and Responsible for the procedure

1. This call, the related forms attached, all information and documents relating to the selection process are published on the CREF institutional website (www.cref.it) on the “Competitions and notices” page.

Article 10– Data processing

1. Submission of an application for admission to the selection entails, for the purposes of managing the selection procedure, the processing of applicant's personal data in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27, 2016 (hereinafter referred to as the Regulation).
2. In accordance with Article 13 of the Regulation, CREF, as Data Controller, informs applicants of the procedure that the personal data provided and/or otherwise acquired will be used exclusively for purposes related to and instrumental to the conduct of the competition procedure, as specified below. In particular, CREF will process personal data (name, surname, date and place of birth, tax code, residence, citizenship), contact details, identity document/residence permit, curriculum vitae, qualifications, and any other information provided by the applicant when submitting their application. Please note that, at the applicant's request, special categories of data may also be collected and processed, including (i) judicial data (e.g., any criminal convictions), (ii) health data (e.g., disabilities, including temporary ones).



3. The processing of personal data provided is based on:
 - i. Article 6(b) of the GDPR: “processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract”;
 - ii. Article 6(c) of the GDPR: “processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject”;
 - iii. Article 6(e) of the GDPR “processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller” and is aimed at managing the selection procedure, in all its phases, from verifying that the requirements are met to ascertaining that there are no impediments to participation, up to the publication of the ranking list and the possible conclusion of the employment contract.
4. Any judicial data and data relating to health provided are supplied voluntarily by the applicants and exclusively to enable CREF to perform its public functions in protecting its interests in connection with the selection procedure. For this reason, although they are of a special nature, pursuant to Article 9(2) of the GDPR, the applicant’s consent to processing is not required. The provision of data is mandatory therefore, any refusal to provide it will result in exclusion from the selection process.
5. The processing of the applicant’s personal data is carried out, including with the aid of electronic means, by means of the operations indicated in Article 4(2) of the GDPR, namely: the processing of personal data may consist of the collection, recording, organization, consultation, processing, modification, selection, extraction, comparison, use, interconnection, blocking, communication, erasure, and destruction of data.
6. The applicant’s data will be disclosed to CREF staff, as well as to members of the Examination Board, who are specifically authorized to process such data, and to data processors, external consultants, legal, tax, and labor advisors, or the company that manages the databases where this data is stored. It should be noted that CREF may also communicate the personal data it holds to other public administrations if they need to process it for any procedures falling within their institutional competence, as well as to all those public entities to which, under certain conditions, communication is required by EU provisions, laws, or regulations. In particular, data may also be disclosed to: Certifying administrations when checking substitute declarations made for the purposes of Presidential Decree No. 445/2000, Judicial authorities.
7. The applicant’s personal and/or specific data are processed within the European Union and are not disclosed. If necessary, for technical or operational reasons, the Data Controller reserves the right to transfer personal data to countries outside the European Union for which there are “adequacy” decisions by the European Commission, or on the basis of adequate safeguards provided by the country to which the data is to be transferred, or on the basis of specific exemptions provided for in the Regulation.



8. The aforementioned data will be stored for as long as necessary to carry out the competition procedure and in view of potential legal actions that may be taken, or, in the event of a pending dispute, until the relevant judgment becomes final. Subsequently, at the conclusion of the administrative or judicial proceedings, the data will be stored in accordance with the rules on the storage of documentation provided for by the Public Administration. Furthermore, it should be noted that the Data Controller may be obliged to retain personal data for a longer period in compliance with a legal obligation or by order of an Authority. At the end of the retention period, personal data will be deleted.
9. Pursuant to and for the purposes of the Regulation, data subjects have the right to obtain from the Data Controller, in the cases provided for, access to personal data and the rectification or erasure of such data or the restriction of processing concerning them or to object to the processing (Articles 15 et seq. of the Regulation). If the data subject considers that the processing of personal data is in violation of the provisions of the Regulation, they have the right to lodge a complaint with the Supervisory Authority, as provided for in Article 77 of the Regulation itself, or to take appropriate legal action (Article 79 of the Regulation).

Article 11 – Final provisions

1. For any other aspect call, please refer to the CREF regulations concerning the awarding of scholarships, adopted by the Board of Directors with resolution no. 58/2025, and to current legislation.
2. By submitting an application to participate in the selection process, applicants implicitly accept, without reservation, all the provisions contained in this call for applications.
3. CREF reserves the right – including on the basis of possible effects of new legislation or regulations and/or its own organizational changes – not to proceed with this procedure.
4. In case of a discrepancy between the English and Italian versions of this Call, the Italian version will prevail.
